



## **CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION 2016 FOR CITIZENS OF THE REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA**

Candidates will be admitted on the basis of:

- the average mark of the Baccalaureate examinations for Baccalaureate Diploma owners.
- the average mark of Bachelor's degree examinations, for the owners of Diploma of higher education or Diploma of Bachelor's degree or an equivalent document.
- average mark for the specialty practical examinations;
- average mark for the examination in the Romanian language (for foreign and alolingual students).

### **APPLICATION PERIOD AND ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS**

#### **STEP I: Application of candidates.**

The candidates may apply for the entrance examinations by filling in the online application form on the website of APSA.

#### **STEP II: Submitting the set of documents for the competition for admission**

To take part in entrance examinations candidates should fill in an application form and attach the following documents:

- **The original** and copy of the document certifying completion of your studies and its attachment;
- Medical certificate (form 086/e), issued in the year of admission;
- 6 3x4 photos (ID type), on photo paper;
- Identity card (passport), original and copy;
- Military card or recruit certificate (for those subject to military service);
- Excerpt from Employment record book (for those employed);
- Diplomas of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> degree, in republican and international competitions in specialty subjects, as well as diplomas certifying your participation in different contests, exhibitions, etc.;

#### **STEP III: Entrance Examinations and Announcing the Results.**

Admission to the 1st year in APSA is organised on a competitive basis, in compliance with the law in force.

Entrance examinations at the Faculty of Fine Arts, Specialty Painting include:

**1. Practical exam in Drawing.** Portrait – drawing from model (9 hours). Technique: the candidate will choose the technique and easel drawing materials – coal, sanguine, sous etc. Size: 40 / 50 cm.

**2. Practical exam in Painting.** Portrait – painting from model (9 hours). Technique: oil on canvas. Size: 40 / 50 cm.

**3. Practical exam in Composition.** Creating a composition on a given topic. (6 hours). Technique: oil on canvas. Size: maximum size of the longest side 70 cm.

**4. Interview: oral**

The candidate will present in front of the Admissions Board works previously created by him/her. These will be not more than 20 artworks created from model (drawings, paintings, compositions, sketches, etc.)

**5. The Romanian language examination: oral and written.** Compulsory examination for foreign students.

Note! All materials for all practical tests (painting, drawing, composition) included in the admission methodology will NOT be supplied by the Academy. The candidate must purchase all these materials.

### TUITION FEE

**Tuition fee** at the Faculty of Fine Arts, specialty Painting, is EUR 5000 per academic year, for citizens of the Republic of Moldova and for those in the Romanian diaspora.

Annually, on the basis of the admission plan of the Academy, Bachelor Degree studies, 25 % of the allocated places are financed by APSA. Thus, students may have their tuition fee paid by APSA. The selection is made during the entrance examinations, by the Admissions Board based on the average mark for specialty practical exams (drawing, painting, composition). Candidates who get the highest average mark for admission will have their tuition fee paid for the academic year. For the following year, students with the highest annual average mark are selected.

Under a partnership agreement with the Academy of Painting "Stati Art", Academic Foundation for Education and Culture "Voice of Art" in Romania financed, the equivalent tuition fee of EUR 5,000 for 4 students from APSA, for the academic year 2015 - 2016. The program aims to give young people the chance to continue their university studies and to develop their skills in the field of easel painting.

### SCHOLARSHIPS

**In APSA, the most talented students with the highest professional skills are offered the following types of scholarships:**

a) **merit-based scholarships**

b) **performance scholarships**

c) **social scholarships**

**Merit-based** scholarships are granted to students in descending order of general average mark obtained in the exam period preceding the term in which the grant is requested (term II) or in the previous academic year (term I). Merit-based Scholarship aims to help stimulate students' professional preparation in the field of easel painting.

For outstanding artistic performance during the first term, two students were granted APSA merit-based scholarship. The scholarship is allocated during the second term of academic year 2015 - 2016, and is 500 lei per month.

**Performance scholarships** are granted on competitive basis to students from the Bachelor study programme, depending on the average mark obtained and for outstanding artistic performance. Scholarships may be granted for one academic year or for all the 4 years of study. If the student fails to

meet the performance criteria for which he/she was granted scholarship, APSA has the right to withdraw the scholarship and grant it to another student who meets the requirements.

Performance scholarship includes work materials and participation in creative camps twice a year.

**Social scholarships** are granted at the request of students, confirming outstanding artistic performance and who submit documents proving that they belong to the category of socially vulnerable families. Social scholarships usually include work materials, accommodation and participation in creative camps.

Scholarships are allocated based on the Regulation on the granting of scholarships approved by APSA. The amount of money is set at the beginning of each academic year.
